

 1 fully cooked bone-in ham (8 to 10 pounds)
 4 chipotle peppers in adobo sauce, minced

 1 cup packed brown sugar
 3 garlic cloves, minced

 3 tablespoons honey
 1-1/2 teaspoons Dijon mustard

 2 tablespoons cider vinegar
 3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon

 2 u/d cup cinegra al
 2/4 cups conground cinnamon

1 ruly cooked bone-in nam (8 to 10 pounds) 1 cup packed brown sugar 3 tablespoons honey 2 tablespoons cider vinegar 2-1/4 cups ginger ale 3/4 teaspoon ground cumin Prep Time: 10 min. Bake, uncovered, 1-1/2 hours Ø Meanwhile, for glaze, in a small saucepan, mix brown sugar, honey, vinegar and ginger ale. Bring to a boil; cook until mixture is reduced by half, about 15 minutes. Stir in remaining ingredients. Reduce heat; simmer, uncovered, 5 minutes.
