Monkey land: In a village called Upla, in the Osmanabad district of India's Maharashtra state, monkeys are so well respected that they have been given their own land. 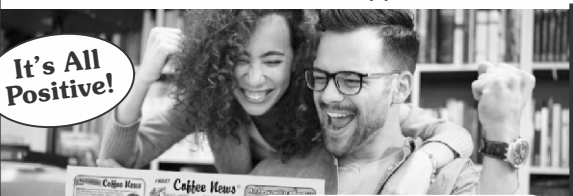
