# Recipe of the month

## Grilled Glazed Drumsticks


1 cup ketchup 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder  
 1/3 cup reduced-sodium soy sauce 3 pounds fresh or frozen chicken drumsticks, thawed  
 4 teaspoons honey Optional: Sliced green onions and ranch dressing  
 3/4 teaspoon ground ginger

Prep Time: 10 min. + marinating Grill Time: 15 min.  
Yield: Approximately 2 dozen

- In a small bowl, combine the first 5 ingredients. Pour 1 cup marinade into a large shallow dish. Add the chicken; turn to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours or overnight. Cover and refrigerate remaining marinade for basting.
- Drain chicken, discarding marinade. Grill, covered, over medium heat until juices run clear, 15-20 minutes, turning and basting occasionally with reserved marinade. If desired, top with sliced green onions and serve with ranch dressing.

**Monkey land:** In a village called Upla, in the Osmanabad district of India's Maharashtra state, monkeys are so well respected that they have been given their own land. Along with a small population of humans, Upla has about 100 Rhesus macaques in residence. Some years ago, the village set aside 32 acres of land and put them in the name of all the monkeys. No one knows exactly how or when this came to be, but the townsfolk feed the monkeys and often include them in rituals. Known as Mr. Doodle, Cox uses his love of this artistic style to make paintings, which have sold for high prices at auctions.
