**Everybody's Talking**

**Adopted piglet:** Last fall, a German farmer was tickled pink to discover that a baby wild boar had found a new family in his herd of cattle. 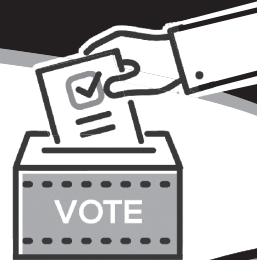
