Adopted piglet: Last fall, a German farmer was tickled pink to discover that a baby wild boar had found a new family in his herd of cattle. Recipe of the month

Grilled Glazed Drumsticks

1 cup ketchup
 1/3 cup reduced-sodium soy sauce
 4 teaspoons honey
 3/4 teaspoon ground ginger

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
 3 pounds fresh or frozen chicken drumsticks, thawed
 Optional: Sliced green onions and ranch dressing

Prep Time: 10 min. + marinating Grill Time: 15 min.
 Yield: Approximately 2 dozen

1 In a small bowl, combine the first 5 ingredients. Pour 1 cup marinade into a large shallow dish. Add the chicken; turn to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours or overnight. Cover and refrigerate remaining marinade for basting.
 2 Drain chicken, discarding marinade. Grill, covered, over medium heat until juices run clear, 15-20 minutes, turning and basting occasionally with reserved marinade. If desired, top with sliced green onions and serve with ranch dressing.
