## Everybody's Talking

# Recipe of the month



## Grilled Glazed Drummies

1 cup ketchup      1/2 teaspoon garlic powder  
1/3 cup reduced-sodium soy sauce      3 pounds fresh or frozen chicken drumettes, thawed  
4 teaspoons honey      Optional: Sliced green onions and ranch dressing  
3/4 teaspoon ground ginger

Prep Time: 10 min. + marinating      Grill Time: 15 min.  
Yield: Approximately 2 dozen

❶ In a small bowl, combine the first 5 ingredients. Pour 1 cup marinade into a large shallow dish. Add the chicken; turn to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours or overnight. Cover and refrigerate remaining marinade for basting.

❷ Drain chicken, discarding marinade. Grill, covered, over medium heat until juices run clear, 15-20 minutes, turning and basting occasionally with reserved marinade. If desired, top with sliced green onions and serve with ranch dressing.




