Everybody's Talking!

Burnt offerings: Crusty on the outside and chewy on the inside sound like a perfect combination for dinner rolls. However, the bread product in question is known as "heavy-fired" or "well-fired" rolls, and they can be as black as extremely burnt toast on the outside. Bakeries in Scotland have made these buns for many decades, and often sell out of their day's supply early in the morning. Some people love the charred offerings, finding them addictive. Others think the buns are a huge joke, wondering how a bakery could possibly get away with burning their wares, and then selling them. There is even some debate about whether the burnt tops are carcinogenic.


