

The artist uses black and white inks to create surreal and gothic works of art. A fish's head on a bent knee turns into a butterfly when the client stands up, while a close-mouthed frog tattooed on an arm turns into an open-mouth reptile as the elbow is unbent. When he is not creating images on skin, Hillik paints fascinating images on canvas.
