Everybody's Talking

Lying down: Everyone knows about ski competitions, bicycle races, and running marathons, but the village of Brezna, Montenegro, has a unique one. During their "lying down competition," people lie down for as long as they can. The competition has taken place annually for over a decade; in 2022, the winner was Zarko Pejanovic. With the exception of allowable washroom breaks, this winner stayed prone for 60 hours, beating out his nine competitors. The unusual event started because organizers wanted to make fun of the stereotype that people from Montenegro are lazy. Pejanovic was happy to take first prize, which included 350 Euros in cash, plus other rewards.

Balancing act: Wang Yekun of Hong Kong really knows how to keep things in balance, quite literally! He puts various items on top of each other and figures out how to make them stay there. For example, he placed two bottles on the ground, positioned a third bottle on top of the first two, and then balanced a bicycle on top of the bottles. Other items he's used in his precarious arrangements include sewing machines, wrenches, gas cylinders, bricks, and cell phones. The skill started as a hobby, and now his patience has paid off. He has quite a following on social media by people who are amazed at his clever ability.

Salty wall: Although the action is not condoned by public health authorities, patrons of The Mission restaurant in Scottsdale, Arizona, sometimes lick the establishment's walls. That's because the walls in question are made of Himalayan salt blocks. Owner Matt Carter got the idea to build pink salt walls after he visited a Chicago restaurant that boasted a room lined with salt rocks. He claims that he does not encourage his customers to stick out their tongues for a taste in his own restaurant, unless, of course, it is to lick the salt block that comes with the tortillas. Or patrons can buy a small block of Himalayan salt to take home with them.

Born in New York, N.Y., in 1984, Peldon has worked as a child actor in such shows as *Guiding Light*, *The '70s Show*, and *Ghost World*. But an actor may not be able to scream on cue, regardless of their acting ability. That's where Peldon steps in, providing the exact feeling needed to make the scene come to life.
