Everybody's Talking

Burnt offerings: Crusty on the outside and chewy on the inside sound like a perfect combination for dinner rolls. However, the bread product in question is known as "heavy-fired" or "well-fired" rolls, and they can be as black as extremely burnt toast on the outside. Bakeries in Scotland have made these buns for many decades, and often sell out of their day's supply early in the morning. Some people love the charred offerings, finding them addictive. Recipe of the month

Grilled Glazed Drumsticks

1 cup ketchup
 1/3 cup reduced-sodium soy sauce
 4 teaspoons honey
 3/4 teaspoon ground ginger

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
 3 pounds fresh or frozen chicken drumsticks, thawed
 Optional: Sliced green onions and ranch dressing

Prep Time: 10 min. + marinating Grill Time: 15 min.
 Yield: Approximately 2 dozen

1 In a small bowl, combine the first 5 ingredients. Pour 1 cup marinade into a large shallow dish. Add the chicken; turn to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours or overnight. Cover and refrigerate remaining marinade for basting.
 2 Drain chicken, discarding marinade. Grill, covered, over medium heat until juices run clear, 15-20 minutes, turning and basting occasionally with reserved marinade. If desired, top with sliced green onions and serve with ranch dressing.

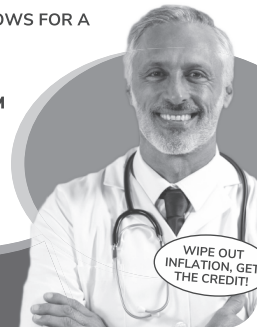
