Burnt offerings: Crusty on the outside and chewy on the inside sound like a perfect combination for dinner rolls. However, the bread product in question is known as "heavy-fired" or "well-fired" rolls, and they can be as black as extremely burnt toast on the outside. Bakeries in Scotland have made these buns for many decades, and often sell out of their day's supply early in the morning. Some people love the charred offerings, finding them addictive. It's not a trick. As a pup, Dexter was injured in a mishap with a car, leaving him with the use of only his hind legs. Pasek got him a doggy wheelchair, but before long, Dexter had abandoned the chair in favour of walking upright on his hind legs.
