



Did You Know...

Old tree: The Alerce Costero National Park in Chile is the home of a very old tree, possibly the world's oldest. It's a Patagonian cypress known as Gran Abuelo ("great-grandfather") and is estimated to be almost 5,500 years old.

Scenic road: Only one road goes to a village called Cuevas del Agua in northern Spain. Travelers must drive on a narrow roadway that goes through a 300-metre (984-ft.) natural cave, complete with stalagmites and stalactites.

Hear the sound: When movie viewers hear raindrops pattering on a window or piano keys tinkling under someone's fingers, this is "diegetic" sound. The sound happens while the action takes place in the film; it is not added later.

Multi-talented: American musician Prince (1958-2016) played at least 27 instruments, including guitar, bass, piano, drums, and orchestral bells. He also wrote many hit songs performed by others, such as "Manic Monday" by The Bangles. **Delightful sandwich:** A restaurant in Brookings, South Dakota (U.S.), serves a specialty of the state: pheasant sandwich. Made from the meat of this wild fowl, the restaurant's version also includes apples, cranberries, and pecans.
