Bee crazy: Travellers to Provincia di Matera in the southern part of Italy can now get up close and personal with bees. Airbnb owner Rocco Filomeno has found a way to incorporate bees into his accommodation. Calling his place an "air bee and bee," the host offers a one-room house that sits amid nine apiaries.
