Everybody's Talking

Long nails: A nail technician and makeup artist from Gary, Indiana (U.S.), has been growing her fingernails since 1989. Today, Cordelia Adams boasts nails that are over 12 inches (30.5 cm) long. With such long nails in the way, taking care of daily duties like brushing your teeth or writing a note may seem impossible, but Adams has managed to work around things. Covered with acrylic overlays, her nails are works of art, and she paints new designs on a regular basis. Adams got her love of long fingernails from her mother, who always sported long, painted nails. She loves the attention her nails bring, and says she'd never give them up.

Money problem: If someone receives an obviously erroneous paycheque that is worth many times more than expected, most people would be honest and let the employer know about the mistake. Not so for a Chilean employee, who quit work and disappeared after being paid many times more than his usual wage. The meat products company accidentally paid out \$165,398,851 (CLP) instead of \$500,000 (CLP). At first, the person agreed to repay the money, but must have had second thoughts because the money never reappeared. When the company repeatedly tried to make contact, it could not. The company planned to take legal action to be repaid for its expensive mistake.

That's because the stadium has a railway track running through it, and it's active. The railway was defunct when the stadium was built in the 1980s. However, locals wanted to reactivate the historic tracks, and they did so. Now, during the summers, a steam-powered engine pulls train cars full of tourists who are determined to view the area's scenery. While it seems odd, the sight of a train chugging past the grandstand in the middle of a game has become a highlight for both spectators and the train's passengers.

However, an elderly widow from Looe in Cornwall, England, got the surprise of her long life when she discovered her late husband's wedding ring in the garden after it had been lost for 35 years. Recipe of the month

Island Mango Slaw

1/2 medium head Savoy cabbage, thinly sliced into 3-inch strips (about 8 cups)
1/2 small head red cabbage, thinly sliced into 3-inch strips (about 6 cups)
2 medium carrots, cut into thin 2-inch strips
1 small sweet yellow pepper, cut into thin 2-inch strips
1 small sweet red pepper, cut into thin 2-inch strips
1 small red onion, halved and thinly sliced
1/2 medium mango, peeled, and coarsely chopped, cut into thin 2-inch strips

1/2 jalapeno pepper, seeded and finely chopped
Dressing:
1/2 cup plain Greek yogurt
1/4 cup thawed orange juice concentrate
4 teaspoons lime juice
1/2 teaspoon olive oil
1/2 medium mango, peeled and coarsely chopped
2 teaspoons minced fresh gingerroot
1 teaspoon kosher salt
1/2 jalapeno pepper, seeded and coarsely chopped
1/4 teaspoon pepper

Prep Time: 25 min. + chilling Yield: 12 servings

1 In a serving bowl, combine first 8 ingredients. Process dressing ingredients in a blender until smooth. Toss dressing with slaw at least 30 minutes before serving. Refrigerate.
