



# Did You Know...

**Big bear:** In Dunbar, Scotland, which is on the coast of the North Sea not far from Edinburgh, is DunBear, a steel statue made by sculptor Andy Scott. In the shape of a bear, it honours Dunbar-born naturalist John Muir.

**Crazy cake:** Flying Monkey Bakery in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (U.S.), invented the two-layer pumpple cake. On bottom is a chocolate cake with a pumpkin pie inside, and on top, a vanilla cake hides an apple pie.

**Furious winds:** A storm is considered a hurricane when its sustained winds reach 74 miles (119 km) per hour or more. The Saffir-Simpson Wind Scales rates them Category 1 through Category 5. Category 5 is the most dangerous.
