Bee crazy: Travelers to Provincia di Matera in the southern part of Italy can now get up close and personal with bees. Airbnb owner Rocco Filomeno has found a way to incorporate bees into his accommodation. Calling his place an "air bee and bee," the host offers a one-room house that sits amid nine apiaries. Recipe of the month

Island Mango Slaw

1/2 medium head Savoy cabbage, thinly sliced into 3-inch strips (about 8 cups)

1/2 small head red cabbage, thinly sliced into 3-inch strips (about 6 cups)

2 medium carrots, cut into thin 2-inch strips

1 small sweet yellow pepper, cut into thin 2-inch strips

1 small sweet red pepper, cut into thin 2-inch strips

1 small red onion, halved and thinly sliced

1/2 medium mango, peeled, and coarsely chopped

1/2 jalapeno pepper, seeded and finely chopped

Dressing:

1/2 cup plain Greek yogurt

1/4 cup thawed orange juice concentrate

4 teaspoons lime juice

1/2 teaspoon olive oil

1/2 medium mango, peeled and coarsely chopped

2 teaspoons minced fresh gingerroot

1 teaspoon kosher salt

1/2 jalapeno pepper, seeded and coarsely chopped

1/4 teaspoon pepper

Prep Time: 25 min. + chilling Yield: 12 servings

In a serving bowl, combine first 8 ingredients. Process dressing ingredients in a blender until smooth. Toss dressing with slaw at least 30 minutes before serving. Refrigerate.
