Bee crazy: Travelers to Provincia di Matera in the southern part of Italy can now get up close and personal with bees. Airbnb owner Rocco Filomeno has found a way to incorporate bees into his accommodation. Calling his place an "air bee and bee," the host offers a one-room house that sits amid nine apiaries. The high ceiling of the wooden structure has a glass hive through which guests can watch a colony of bees hard at work. They can go to sleep at night hearing the soft buzzing and smelling the gentle scent of the bees and their honey. The accommodation is situated on Filomeno's olive farm near the village of Grottole.



Did You Know...
