Bee crazy: Travelers to Provincia di Matera in the southern part of Italy can now get up close and personal with bees. Airbnb owner Rocco Filomeno has found a way to incorporate bees into his accommodation. Calling his place an "air bee and bee," the host offers a one-room house that sits amid nine apiaries. The high ceiling of the wooden structure has a glass hive through which guests can watch a colony of bees hard at work. Recipe of the month

Banana Split Icebox Cake



1 carton (16 ounces) frozen whipped topping, thawed
1 cup sour cream
1 package (3.4 ounces) instant vanilla pudding mix

1 can (8 ounces) crushed pineapple, drained
24 whole graham crackers
2 medium bananas, sliced
Toppings: Chocolate syrup, halved fresh strawberries and additional banana slices

Prep Time: 30 min. + chilling Yield: 10 servings


- In a large bowl, mix whipped topping, sour cream and pudding mix until blended; fold in pineapple. Cut a small hole in the tip of a pastry bag. Transfer pudding mixture to bag.
- On a flat serving plate, arrange 4 crackers in a rectangle. Pipe about 1 cup pudding mixture over crackers; top with about 1/4 cup banana slices. Repeat layers 5 times. Refrigerate, covered, overnight
- Just before serving, top with chocolate syrup, strawberries and additional banana slices.
