



# Did You Know...


**Heightened status:** The Grand Canyon in Arizona (U.S.) became a National Park in 1919, while an original, smaller version of today's Grand Teton National Park in Wyoming received that status in 1929.

**Long horns:** A spider that looks scary but won't hurt humans is the long horned orb-weaver (Macracantha arcuata). Its distinguishing feature is the presence of two spiny "horns" that grow from its sides.

**Moon time:** The planet Mars has two moons, Phobos and Deimos. Phobos is close to the planet's surface and completes three orbits in each Martian day, which is about 17 minutes longer than an Earth day.

**Ear movement:** Not many people can move their outer ears back and forth, like a cat. However, humans have three auricular muscles that some folks are able to voluntarily engage, making for an interesting trick. **On TV:** The first, full National Hockey League game on TV was on February 25, 1940, on New York's W2XBS, an experimental station.
