Raincoat nabber: For over a decade, women in Osaka, Japan, have had to keep a sharp eye on their raincoats. That is because someone was stealing the hooded, poncho-type garments, known as kappa. Luckily, the culprit was caught. His name is Yoshio Yoda, and he would nab the items out of baskets on bicycles that were left unattended in the parking lots of such places as train stations and shopping malls. And he hadn't stolen just one or two raincoats; after searching the man's home, police discovered that he had snatched more than 360 of the ponchos during his reign of raincoat theft. He has become known as "Raincoat Man."

Recipe of the month

Banana Split Icebox Cake

1 carton (16 ounces) frozen whipped topping, thawed
1 cup sour cream
1 package (3.4 ounces) instant vanilla pudding mix

1 can (8 ounces) crushed pineapple, drained
24 whole graham crackers
Toppings: Chocolate syrup, halved fresh strawberries and additional banana slices

Prep Time: 30 min. + chilling Yield: 10 servings

- In a large bowl, mix whipped topping, sour cream and pudding mix until blended; fold in pineapple. Cut a small hole in the tip of a pastry bag. Transfer pudding mixture to bag.
- On a flat serving plate, arrange 4 crackers in a rectangle. Pipe about 1 cup pudding mixture over crackers; top with about 1/4 cup banana slices. Repeat layers 5 times. Refrigerate, covered, overnight.
- Just before serving, top with chocolate syrup, strawberries and additional banana slices.

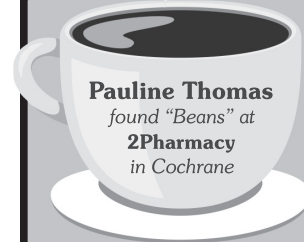
