


Big bill: In 1934, the U.S. government printed a \$100,000 bill, the highest denomination ever issued. However, the bill was never used for general purposes. Imagine what would

In a large mixing bowl, combine shredded zucchini, breadcrumbs, Parmesan, egg, oil, garlic powder, paprika, Italian seasoning, salt, and pepper. Mix well until evenly combined.Take 2 spoonfuls of the zucchini mixture at a time
