YAMNUSKA WOLFDOG SANCTUARY

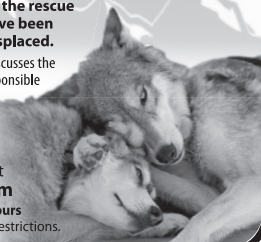
Located at 263156 Range Rd 53, on the 1A Hwy

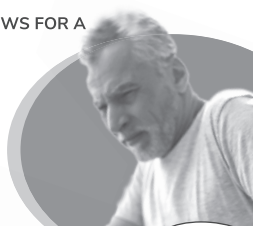

Recipe of the month

Zucchini Bites

2 cups shredded zucchini
1 cup Panko breadcrumbs
½ cup Parmesan cheese
1 large egg
1 tablespoon vegetable oil

½ teaspoon garlic powder
½ teaspoon paprika
½ teaspoon Italian seasoning
½ teaspoon salt (or to taste)
¼ teaspoon ground black pepper (or to taste)

Total Time: 25 min. Yield: 20 pieces/4 servings

- Use a box grater or food processor to shred the zucchini.
- In a large mixing bowl, combine shredded zucchini, breadcrumbs, Parmesan, egg, oil, garlic powder, paprika, Italian seasoning, salt, and pepper. Mix well until evenly combined.
- Take 2 spoonfuls of the zucchini mixture at a time and shape into 1.5-inch balls. Set aside on a plate.
- Bake in a 375F preheated oven for 15 minutes until golden brown.
- Serve immediately with your favourite dipping sauce, if desired.
