**River road:** A road in China is known as the River Highway for good reason. It was built in the middle of the Xiangxi River. Another highway snakes along the edge of this river, but a bigger one was needed. Rather than blasting a lot of rock and making tunnels in this mountainous region, engineers decided putting the new, 6.8-mile (10.9-km) road above the water would be less expensive. Another benefit is that people who live on the shoreline did not have to be displaced. The highway allows people in Xingshan County in Hubei to connect with a high-speed route to Shanghai, cutting the travel time. The amazing infrastructure has become a tourist attraction.

**Recipe of the month**

**Apple Cider Pork Chops**

2 tablespoons olive oil  
6 boneless pork loin chops (6 to 8 ounces each), about 3/4 inch thick  
1 garlic clove, minced  
1 tablespoon Dijon mustard  
1 teaspoon honey  
1/2 teaspoon apple pie spice

1/2 teaspoon coarsely ground pepper  
1/4 teaspoon dried thyme  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1 cup apple cider  
1 tablespoon plus 1 teaspoon cornstarch  
2 tablespoons water  
Minced fresh parsley

Prep/Total Time: 25 min. Yield: 6 servings

- In a large skillet, heat olive oil over medium heat. Brown pork chops on both sides.
- Meanwhile, in a small bowl, combine next 7 ingredients; stir in apple cider. Pour over pork chops. Reduce heat to medium-low; cook, covered, until a thermometer inserted into chops reads 145°, 4-5 minutes. Remove chops from skillet; let stand for 5 minutes.
- In a small bowl, mix cornstarch and water until smooth; stir into cider mixture in skillet. Return to a boil, stirring constantly; cook and stir until thickened, 1-2 minutes. Pour over chops; sprinkle with fresh parsley.
