Everybody's Talking

Salty place: Anyone who wants to fill a salt shaker, and happens to be near eastern Germany, need look no further than Monte Kali. This mountain of salt, located near the town of Heringen, contains enough of the condiment to fill an infinite number of shakers. The landmark towers over the area and can be seen for miles. The salt started accumulating in the 1970s when potash mining companies needed a place to store sodium chloride, which is a byproduct of the industry. But when a jockey fell off a horse during the Tokay Stakes 2023 race in Nagoya, Japan, the horse went on to finish first! The horse's name is Vanyar, and the unfortunate jockey lost his balance and went flying at the beginning of the race. Instead of Vanyar simply wandering off the course, as jockeyless horses usually do, the determined animal continued on, keeping perfect pace with the others, and speeding up near the end. Although Vanyar's "win" was not legitimate, he earned praises from onlookers for his prowess.
