Rock story: A young Canadian girl who likes to collect pretty rocks almost lost one of her favourites, but got it back. Georgia LeMasurier, from New Brunswick on the country's east coast, was visiting her grandmother in British Columbia on the west coast. The mall-style store has departments for everything from toys to food to technology, along with home decor, clothing and much more. There's even a hotel for those who want to spend multiple days shopping for deals to their hearts' content.
