Everybody's Talking

Lit up lobes: An American fashion designer named Diana Caldarescu has come up with a novel idea that is turning the lights on, literally, in the jewelry industry. She created earrings that look like tiny chandeliers, compete with crystals and brass candleholders. They attach to the ear using a wrap rather than the usual stud or clip. What's more, these earrings actually light up! Caldarescu figured out a way to charge the lights with a battery pack designed to be concealed behind the earlobe. Everything is in miniature size, of course. The earrings are so popular that Caldarescu is having a hard time keeping them in stock.

Rare fig tree: Bacoli, a city on the west coast of Italy, is home to ancient ruins called Parco Archeologico delle Terme di Baia. Upon discovery, he was confused and couldn't speak the local language, but he was taken to the hospital and soon recovered.

Returned vehicle: A car thief in Nova Scotia (Canada) turned out not to be a thief after all. When a woman returned to the parking lot where she'd left her Hyundai Santa Fe, she found it missing. She immediately called police. But the "thief," who owned an almost identical vehicle, had taken the woman's car by mistake. For some reason, his key fob worked on her SUV, so off he went to run his next errands, which included stopping at a gas station to fill up. Soon, though, he realized he had the wrong Hyundai, so he quickly returned the car. No damage was done, and the woman reimbursed the man for the gas.
