Lit up lobes: An American fashion designer named Diana Caldarescu has come up with a novel idea that is turning the lights on, literally, in the jewelry industry. 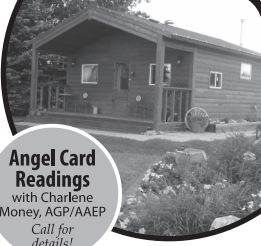

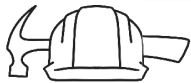

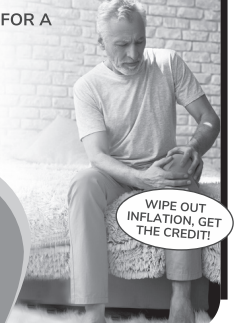

Recipe of the month

Pumpkin Doughnut Drops

- | | |
|--------------------------------|----------------------------|
| 2 large eggs | 3 teaspoons baking powder |
| 1-1/4 cups sugar | 1/2 teaspoon salt |
| 2 tablespoons shortening | 1/2 teaspoon ground |
| 1 cup canned pumpkin | cinnamon |
| 2 teaspoons white vinegar | 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg |
| 1 teaspoon vanilla extract | 1/2 cup lemon-lime soda |
| 3 cups all-purpose flour | Oil for deep-fat frying |
| 1/2 cup nonfat dry milk powder | Additional sugar |

Prep Time: 10 min. Cook: 5 min./batch Yield: 7 dozen

- In a large bowl, beat eggs, sugar and shortening until blended. Beat in pumpkin, vinegar and vanilla. In another bowl, whisk together flour, milk powder, baking powder, salt and spices. Add to egg mixture alternately with soda, beating after each addition.
- In a deep cast-iron skillet or deep-fat fryer, heat oil to 375°. Drop teaspoonfuls of batter, a few at a time, into hot oil. Fry until golden brown, about 1 minute per side. Drain on paper towels. Roll in additional sugar while warm.
