Good driver: A little boy from Turkey is proving to be quite a good driver. 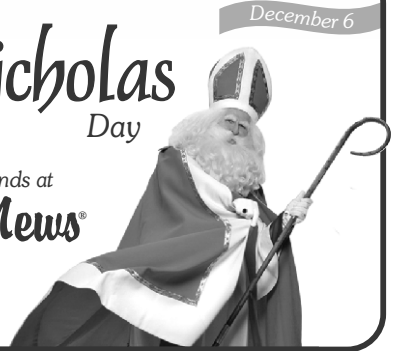
