**Recipe of the month**

**Pumpkin Doughnut Drops**


2 large eggs	3 teaspoons baking powder
1-1/4 cups sugar	1/2 teaspoon salt
2 tablespoons shortening	1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1 cup canned pumpkin	1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
2 teaspoons white vinegar	1/2 cup lemon-lime soda
1 teaspoon vanilla extract	Oil for deep-fat frying
3 cups all-purpose flour	Additional sugar
1/2 cup nonfat dry milk powder	

Prep Time: 10 min. Cook: 5 min./batch Yield: 7 dozen

1 In a large bowl, beat eggs, sugar and shortening until blended. Beat in pumpkin, vinegar and vanilla. In another bowl, whisk together flour, milk powder, baking powder, salt and spices. Add to egg mixture alternately with soda, beating after each addition.

2 In a deep cast-iron skillet or deep-fat fryer, heat oil to 375°. Drop teaspoonfuls of batter, a few at a time, into hot oil. Fry until golden brown, about 1 minute per side. Drain on paper towels. Roll in additional sugar while warm.

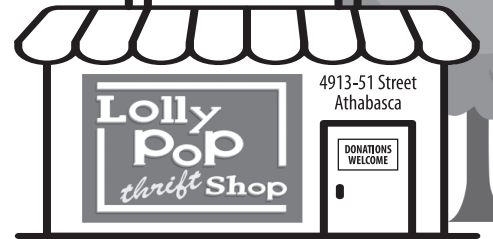

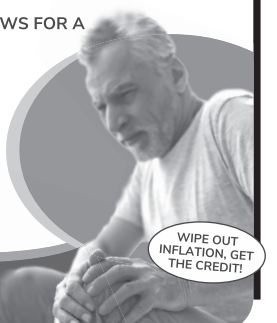
