Good food: Different regions of the world have their own iconic street foods. The two men have a similar appearance, so the guard allowed Roman to pick up his cellmate's keys, wallet, and clothes, and walk away from the facility. Prison staff realized the mistake when the cellmate woke up and asked when he could leave. A day later, authorities found Roman and brought him back to his cell.

After 21 hours, the poor fellow finally gave up. Hopefully, his heart will heal soon.






