Good food: Different regions of the world have their own iconic street foods. In North America, vendors serve hot dogs out of trucks, and in England, hungry folks can usually find a fish-and-chips seller. On the Caribbean island country of Guadeloupe, the most famous street food is bokit. It is a sandwich famous for its bread: crispy, delicious, and fried. With this special bread forming the base, what's inside the sandwich is up to the imagination. Common items are saltfish and conch, but can also be chicken, lamb, chickpeas, or whatever else a sandwich maker prefers. Then cooks add accompanying toppings, such as lettuce, cheese, peppers, and various sauces. Sweet versions are eaten as dessert.
