## Did You Kuou...

Oscar wins: American actor Tom Hanks has received six Oscar nominations for Best Actor in a Leading Role. He won two, for the title role in Forrest Gump (1995) and as Andrew Beckett in Philadelphia (1994).
Impressive size: Giant sequoia trees in California's Sierra Nevada mountain range (U.S.) grow to be very big, and old! Some are known to have lived for 3,000 years. They can be 250 to 300 feet ( 76 to 91 m ) tall.
Busy place: Kyoto, Japan, is home to the Nishiki Market which has been operating for 700 years. Its five blocks of alleyways have over 100 vendor stalls that sell everything from soy donuts to pickles, grilled squid, and cookware.
