The location is about 150 km (93 mi.) northeast of Calgary. With the local coal mine long closed, Wayne is considered a ghost town. Still operating in a 1923 structure, the Last Chance Saloon and Rose Deer Hotel is decorated with artifacts, including a few framed bullet holes. Today, this little town has only a handful of permanent residents, but in the early 1900s, more than 3,000 called it home. Although just a hamlet with a history, Wayne welcomes many visitors looking for a unique slice of history.






