Gas guzzler: Huge, big box shopping malls are the norm all over the United States, but now there is a huge gas station, complete with stores, a restaurant, and a large rest area, in Sevierville, Tennessee. The complex, owned by gas station chain Buc-ee's, is 74,000 square feet (6875 sq. m), with 120 gas pumps outside. And this station has a soft spot for the little guy: it does not allow big transport trucks to come in and gas up, which creates safety for small vehicles and family vans to navigate the services. Buc-ee's is a well-known chain across the southern part of the country. It intends to build more of these large stations.

Recipe of the month
Stuffed Pizza Bites
 1 tube (13.80 ounces) refrigerated pizza crust
 1/4 cup prepared ranch salad dressing
 6 ounces pepperoni, finely chopped
 1 cup shredded pepper jack cheese
 1/4 cup shredded Romano cheese
 1/4 cup thinly sliced green onions
 1/4 cup chopped green pepper
 4 cooked bacon strips, chopped
 2 teaspoons Italian seasoning
 1 teaspoon garlic powder
 Optional: Marinara sauce or Alfredo sauce, warmed
 Total Time: 30 min. Yield: 1 dozen
 1 Preheat oven to 350°. Grease 12 muffin cups; set aside.
 2 On a lightly floured surface, unroll pizza crust. Spread ranch to within 1/2-in. of edge. Sprinkle with pepperoni, cheeses, green onions, green pepper, bacon and seasonings. Roll up jelly-roll style; pinch the edge closed. Cut crosswise into 12 slices. Place 1 slice in each prepared muffin cup.
 3 Bake until lightly browned, 20-25 minutes. Serve rolls warm, with marinara or Alfredo sauce if desired.
