Everybody's Talking

Annoying renter: When rent is due, good tenants usually pay on time and in full. One renter in Australia pays on time, but not in full, which has so annoyed the landlord that he posted the situation on a peer chat group for advice. Apparently, the tenant shorts the landlord by one cent every month, which isn't much, but the landlord says it's the principle of the situation. He emailed the tenant, asking him to remedy the situation, but the tenant said the law lets him round up or down if amounts are between one and nine cents. The tenant even asked for certain repairs. When the lease expires, the landlord doesn't plan to renew it

Grainy home: Living in a grain silo doesn't seem like a comfortable option, but one near Odessa, Washington (U.S.), may appeal to outdoorsy people. Actually, the abode is comprised of four small silos, three of which are 1,325 square feet (123 sq. m) of interconnected living space; the fourth is a garage. The home, and the 386 acres around it, has many amenities and lots of space, including a fish pond and much rural land for hiking. The current owner, who fixed up the silos to be livable, uses the place as a summer home, but wants to sell it to someone who will be able to enjoy it more often.

Fixing imperfections: Who says a hole in a piece of clothing means the end of the garment? Certainly not Heather Cameron, a textile expert from Gabriola Island off the west coast of Vancouver, Canada. Cameron uses visible mending to fix problems in used clothing, which means that she decorates the flaws rather than hiding them. She might sew a sunburst of yellow stitches around an oval hole, or cover an imperfection with a patch shaped like a guitar or something else that holds personal meaning for the owner. The artist has held well-attended workshops in the area for like-minded people to learn the skill.

Flowery hair: How would you like to have your hair formed into a lily or a chrysanthemum? If so, a hair stylist for you is Nguyen Phat Tri of Vietnam. Although he has a degree in biotechnology, the stylist knew he had a knack for the arts that he needed to pursue. After studying makeup and hairdressing, he started experimenting with floral hair designs, which can take a couple of days or more to complete. He first sketches the design, finds raw material, and finally works with real hair. Many of his customers are bridal parties, who want unique hairstyles for the special day. Celebrities also like his services.

Recipe of the month

Stuffed Pizza Bites

1 tube (13.80 ounces) refrigerated pizza crust
1/4 cup prepared ranch salad dressing
6 ounces pepperoni, finely chopped
1 cup shredded pepper jack cheese
1/4 cup shredded Romano cheese

1/4 cup thinly sliced green onions
1/4 cup chopped green pepper
4 cooked bacon strips, chopped
2 teaspoons Italian seasoning
1 teaspoon garlic powder

Optional: Marinara sauce or Alfredo sauce, warmed

Total Time: 30 min. Yield: 1 dozen

- Preheat oven to 350°. Grease 12 muffin cups; set aside.
- On a lightly floured surface, unroll pizza crust. Spread ranch to within 1/2-in. of edge. Sprinkle with pepperoni, cheeses, green onions, green pepper, bacon and seasonings. Roll up jelly-roll style; pinch the edge closed. Cut crosswise into 12 slices. Place 1 slice in each prepared muffin cup.
- Bake until lightly browned, 20-25 minutes. Serve rolls warm, with marinara or Alfredo sauce if desired.
