## Everybody's Talking

**Scribbled tattoo:** When getting a tattoo, clients choose designs that vary widely and, in the end, it's "to each their own." That's likely what many people say about tattoos by German artist Mykhailo, based in Berlin. One piece of this artist's work looks more like a child's scribbles, with squiggly looking flowers on scrawled stems, along with other lines that don't seem to have any connection to anything. However, the artist first drew the design with a marker, and the client said "yes" to it before the actual inking happened. Mykhailo said he knew the work would be controversial and provocative, which it proved to be on social media.

If they are unable to fly again, she provides a home for them in the refuge she has created in her apartment.
