Scribbled tattoo: When getting a tattoo, clients choose designs that vary widely and, in the end, it's "to each their own." Mykhailo said he knew the work would be controversial and provocative, which it proved to be on social media.

If they are unable to fly again, she provides a home for them in the refuge she has created in her apartment.




