Scribbled tattoo: When getting a tattoo, clients choose designs that vary widely and, in the end, it's "to each their own." Mykhailo said he knew the work would be controversial and provocative, which it proved to be on social media.

Hummingbird haven: An older lady from Mexico City is known for her ability to care for injured hummingbirds. In 2012, a friend brought one of the tiny birds to Catia Lattouf de Arida. Ever since then, she has been nursing the small pollinators back to health. When she realized this was her calling, she started researching the birds, and she has become an expert in their care. When they regain their health, she takes them to an unpopulated spot outside of the city to release them back to the wild. If they are unable to fly again, she provides a home for them in the refuge she has created in her apartment.
