Everybody's Talking

Wild picnic: In Brazil, adventurous diners can enjoy their food while suspended over an enormous waterfall. A company called Rota Aventura has all the equipment set up for the experience, which includes a picnic table dangling on metal cables above Cascata da Sepultura, a large waterfall in the country's southern state of Rio Grande do Sul. Customers are carefully strapped onto the table, which is then rolled out on the cables. Recipe of the month

Stuffed Pizza Bites

1 tube (13.80 ounces) refrigerated pizza crust	1/4 cup thinly sliced green onions
1/4 cup prepared ranch salad dressing	1/4 cup chopped green pepper
6 ounces pepperoni, finely chopped	4 cooked bacon strips, chopped
1 cup shredded pepper jack cheese	2 teaspoons Italian seasoning
1/4 cup shredded Romano cheese	1 teaspoon garlic powder
	Optional: Marinara sauce or Alfredo sauce, warmed

Total Time: 30 min. Yield: 1 dozen

- 1 Preheat oven to 350°. Grease 12 muffin cups; set aside.
- 2 On a lightly floured surface, unroll pizza crust. Spread ranch to within 1/2-in. of edge. Sprinkle with pepperoni, cheeses, green onions, green pepper, bacon and seasonings. Roll up jelly-roll style; pinch the edge closed. Cut crosswise into 12 slices. Place 1 slice in each prepared muffin cup.
- 3 Bake until lightly browned, 20-25 minutes. Serve rolls warm, with marinara or Alfredo sauce if desired.
