**Wild picnic:** In Brazil, adventurous diners can enjoy their food while suspended over an enormous waterfall. A company called Rota Aventura has all the equipment set up for the experience, which includes a picnic table dangling on metal cables above Cascata da Sepultura, a large waterfall in the country's southern state of Rio Grande do Sul. Customers are carefully strapped onto the table, which is then rolled out on the cables. ## Recipe of the month

### Stuffed Pizza Bites

1 tube (13.80 ounces) refrigerated pizza crust  
 1/4 cup prepared ranch salad dressing  
 6 ounces pepperoni, finely chopped  
 1 cup shredded pepper jack cheese  
 1/4 cup shredded Romano cheese

1/4 cup thinly sliced green onions  
 1/4 cup chopped green pepper  
 4 cooked bacon strips, chopped  
 2 teaspoons Italian seasoning  
 1 teaspoon garlic powder

Optional: Marinara sauce or Alfredo sauce, warmed

Total Time: 30 min. Yield: 1 dozen

- 1 Preheat oven to 350°. Grease 12 muffin cups; set aside.
- 2 On a lightly floured surface, unroll pizza crust. Spread ranch to within 1/2-in. of edge. Sprinkle with pepperoni, cheeses, green onions, green pepper, bacon and seasonings. Roll up jelly-roll style; pinch the edge closed. Cut crosswise into 12 slices. Place 1 slice in each prepared muffin cup.
- 3 Bake until lightly browned, 20-25 minutes. Serve rolls warm, with marinara or Alfredo sauce if desired.
