Everybody's Talking

Retired flavours: Ben & Jerry's, renowned for its offbeat ice cream, adopts a unique approach to discontinued varieties with their "Flavor Graveyard." Located at the Ben & Jerry's Factory in Waterbury, Vermont and also pictured on a dedicated page on the company's website, the Graveyard features granite headstones honouring the legacy of "dearly departed" flavours. The Graveyard started in 1997 with only four flavours, but now lists 35 like Wavy Gravy, Dublin Mudslide, Economic Crunch, and Holy Cannoli. The Flavor Graveyard attracts visitors from across the world, allowing ice cream enthusiasts to pay respects to retired recipes. Recently, the flavour What a Cluster was laid to rest with an actual ceremony.

Furry heirs: One wealthy woman in China seems to love her pets more than her three children. The Shanghai woman, with the surname Liu, has an estate worth \$2.8 million and wrote a will to leave her fortune in the care of a local veterinarian appointed as the will administrator. The vet is responsible for the care of her pets. Liu had wanted to leave her money directly to her pets, but that was illegal.
