#### of the month Favourite **Barbecued Chicken** broiler/frver chickens 1/4 cup lemon juice (3 to 4 pounds each), cut into 8 pieces each Salt and pepper **Barbecue Sauce:** 2 tablespoons brown sugar 2 tablespoons orown sugar 2 tablespoons water 1 teaspoon ground mustard 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder 2 tablespoons canola oil 1/4 teaspoon pepper 2 small onions, finely chopped 1/8 teaspoon sal 1/8 teaspoon hot pepper sauce 2 cups ketchup Prep Time: 15 min Grill Time: 35 min Yield: 12 servings • Sprinkle chicken pieces with salt and pepper. Grill, skin side down, uncovered, on a greased rack over medium heat for 20 minutes. Ø Meanwhile, in a small saucepan, make barbecue sauce by beating oil over medium heat. Add onion; sauté until tender. Stir in remaining sauce ingredients and bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer, uncovered, for 10 minutes. Turn chicken; brush with barbecue sauce. Grill 15-25 minutes longer, brushing frequently with sauce until a thermometer reads 165° when inserted in the breast and 170°-175° in the thigh. 


