

Everybody's Talking

Horn reform: In Cambodia, if you install a musical horn in your vehicle, you will be in trouble. The prime minister has ordered police across the country to enforce an order that car owners replace musical horns with normal horns. The leader had seen videos on social media of "inappropriate activity" associated with the musical horns, such as people, especially children and youth, dancing on the roads and roadsides as passing vehicles play tunes, creating a serious safety hazard. He has mandated that any musical horn should be ripped out and replaced with the standard honking kind. While this new law may take away some music from the streets, it aims to significantly improve road safety.

Camelids year: The year 2024 has been designated as the Year of the Camelids, a diverse group of animals including camels, guanacos, and vicunas, which are all part of the camel family, as well as llamas and alpacas. Recognizing their vital role in sustaining the livelihoods of millions of people across 90 countries in harsh environments, the United Nations has bestowed this honour upon them. These remarkable creatures provide essential resources such as food, milk, transportation, fibres, and fertilizer. Particularly notable is the camel's ability to thrive in arid regions with minimal water requirements, which makes them invaluable for transportation across deserts and drylands.

Subsequently, she was arrested again and faced new charges of motor vehicle theft, careless driving, driving without a licence, and failing to report a crash. The stolen truck was returned to its owner.

Rare birth: In the confines of Thomas Belt Zoo in Juigalpa, Nicaragua, a mother puma welcomed three adorable cubs into the world. Two of them boasted a striking golden hue adorned with dark brown spots, while the third stood out due to its pristine white fur. This rare white cub was born with albinism, a condition believed to be shared by only a handful of pumas worldwide. Dubbed Itzae, meaning "Gift from God" in the Mayan language, the cub has quickly become a star attraction since her introduction to the public. Visitors flock to catch a glimpse of this extraordinary feline, marveling at her uncommon beauty and significance in the animal kingdom.



Recipe of the month

One-Pot Chicken & Gnocchi

2 slices bacon, cut into 1/2 inch (1-cm) pieces
6 boneless, skinless chicken thighs (4 oz./125 g each)
1/4 tsp (1 mL) salt
1/8 tsp (0.5 mL) black pepper
1 tbsp (15 mL) Pampered Chef Italian Seasoning Mix, divided

4 garlic cloves, pressed
2 cups (500 mL) 2% or whole milk
1 lb. (450 g) potato gnocchi
2 oz. (60 g) Parmesan cheese, finely grated (1 cup/250 mL)
1/2 cup (125 mL) frozen peas & corn

Ready in 30 minutes Yield: 6 servings

1. Heat the Enamelled Cast Iron Skillet over medium-high heat for 2-3 minutes. Add the bacon and cook until crisp, 5-7 minutes, stirring occasionally. Remove the bacon with slotted spoon, set aside.
2. Season the chicken with the salt, pepper, and 2 tsp (10 mL) Italian seasoning. Add the chicken to the skillet and cook, 5-7 minutes per side, or until the temperature reaches 165°F (74°C). Remove the chicken from the pan and set aside.
3. Reduce the heat to medium, add the garlic, and cook until fragrant, 10-20 seconds. Add the milk, gnocchi, cheese, bacon, and remaining Italian seasoning. Bring to a boil, reduce the heat to medium, and cook, stirring frequently, until the milk has reduced slightly and started to thicken, about 3 minutes.
4. Stir in the peas. Add chicken and cook on medium-low for an additional 3-5 minutes, or until sauce thickens slightly.

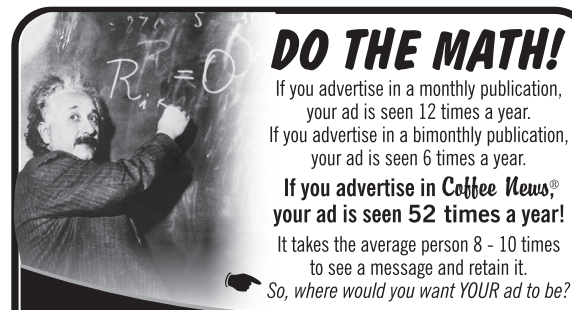
